Dear Hendry Park families,

Earlier I sent you Dr. Wilson's letter through REMIND in regard to the Coronavirus and how it will affect MSD in the coming days.

We will hold school as usual tomorrow, Monday, March 16 during our regular hours. This will give students and staff a chance to prepare themselves for e-learning the rest of the week. E-learning assignments will be given Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday with Friday a waiver day. Teachers will be on duty from 9:00-3:00 these 3 days to help with any questions along with the school office open during this time. Teachers will continue to provide assignments that are creative, keep our students challenged while still working on academic standards. Parents are encouraged to come to pick up student medications stored in our office during this time.

There will be no BASE Camp beginning Monday and continuing during our time away from school. After School Child Care will be open Monday for those already signed up to attend at Carlin Park. Kindergarten Roundup scheduled for March 18 and 19 is also cancelled. The PTO Tuesday night Boy+1 movie has been cancelled as well. Details of our Food Service's plan to continue to provide meals for our students will be available soon.

Teachers will be finalizing 3rd quarter grades by April 6 and grade cards will be mailed home April 7. No e-learning assignments will be sent out during our previously scheduled spring break, March 23 through the 27th. We will be notifying everyone if spring break is to be extended beyond March 23.
